THE ASSESSMENT OF HEALTH MEASURES IN LIFE SPAN: AN APPLIED BEHAVIOURAL PERSPECTIVE







ABSTRACT

The current session is mainly focused on the presentation of a selection of psychometric techniques used to assess mental health and cognitive functions in life span. Specifically, the discussion will be focused on the measurement of fundamental psychological constructs related to mental health and brain organization, such as psychological well-being, depression, pain perception, brain connectivity related to the execution of a cognitive task. Finally, embracing the atypical development perspective, the methodologies used to rate cognitive measures (e.g., motor patterns, intelligence, memory) in typically and atypically developing human beings, as well as stress indexes related to caregiving will be presented. This session intends to provide useful information in order to assess life quality in childhood, early and late adulthood.
