Authors are invited to submit an original full paper (5-6 pages) reporting original researches of theoretical or applied nature using the on-line submission system. The submission should explain the significance of the contribution and contain a list of key references. SPECIAL ISSUE OF IEEE TRANSACTIONS ON INSTRUMENTATION AND MEASUREMENT

A Special Issue of IEEE Transactions on Instrumentation and Measurement (TIM) will be published after the symposium. It will contain papers selected on the basis of the results of regular peer review of the manuscripts. Each manuscript should meet the scope of the TIM and be based on a paper presented at the symposium and published in the symposium proceedings. The manuscript must be significantly extended beyond the scope of the proceedings paper in terms of the overall technical content and research results.
